

INSTRUCTIONS

THIS FORM HAS TO BE FILLED UP BY THE PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE CHILD PARTICIPANT.

Fill in this form to the best of your ability. Remember, this may be the only chance for your child to participate in the Auditions for **SUPER DANCER 2** (the “**Show**”). So THINK about what you are going to write for your child. PLEASE DON'T FORGET THAT THE FORM MUST BE SIGNED. Unsigned Forms shall be liable to be rejected on that ground alone.

PARTICIPANT:

A child who has completed the age of four (4) years but not completed the age of thirteen (13) years as on **05 August, 2017** shall be entitled to participate in the Auditions of the Show. In other words, your ward's FOURTH birthday must have been completed before **05 August, 2017** but your ward's fourteenth birthday must NOT have occurred before **05 August, 2017**.

PARENT/GUARDIAN:

‘Parent’ for the purposes of this Form and the Show shall mean the natural parent of the Participant being his or her biological or adoptive Father or Mother. ‘Guardian’ shall mean such Guardian as appointed by a District Court under the relevant provisions of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 of India (to the extent applicable). Any claim for Guardianship or adoption shall have to be established by way of proper documentation and producer of the Show (“**Producer**”) and/or SPN shall have the sole discretion to decide about allowing such Participants. Other family members, relatives or friends and colleagues shall not be allowed entry into the venue.

ELIGIBILITY:

Employees of SPN, organizers, advertising agency, auditors, organizers’ contractors who have been appointed from time to time, and also employees of the sponsors; and their respective families;, are ineligible to register for the Participants.

DETAILS

Parent/Guardian, while filling this Form shall ensure the following:

1. All information provided in the form is correct and true to the best of knowledge of the Parent/Guardian. Any form which contains a statement or declaration which is false and which the applicant either knows or believes to be false or does not believe to be true shall be liable to be rejected by the Producer and/or SPN and such decision shall not stand contested and/ or be called into question.
2. The form once signed signifies the Parent/Guardian's and consequently their ward's agreement to the conditions set out below.
3. Participant shall produce self-attested copies in support of identity, age and residence of the Parent and identity, age and relationship with the Parent/Guardian of the Participant.
4. The Parent/Guardian has read and agrees to abide by the rules, regulations, terms, and conditions (the “**Rules**”) of “**Super Dancer**” which expression shall include any interview, auditioning process, competition and event relating thereto (the “**Programme**” or “**Show**”) as devised from time to time by the Production House as well as Sony Pictures Networks India Private Limited (“**SPN**”) and shall accept the decision of the Producer as final; and hereby acknowledge that the interests of the Programme shall override those of any Parent/Guardian and Participant.

5. The Parent/Guardian has read, understood, agreed and acknowledged the Terms and Conditions, the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use as put up on the website www.setasia.tv in addition to the conditions set out in this document and has agreed to the terms therein
6. The Parent/Guardian shall abide by any condition and requirement that Organizers require for the purpose of participation by the Participant including the conditions required by the Personal Data Protection Act 2012 (the “PDPA”), the PDPA Regulations and the Parent agrees that Producer has briefed the Parent of the nature of the Programme.
7. The Parent/Guardian by filling in the Form warrants that the Participant is medically fit and healthy to take part in the Programme.
8. A written approval is procured from the Principal or other head of the school giving permission to the Participant to take leave and shoot for the purpose of participation in the Show.
9. The Parent/Guardian by filling in the Form warrants that the Participant has not entered into any commercial or other sponsorship agreement (such as a management contract, recording contract and/or merchandising contract) or arrangement with any person, firm or company in respect of appearance of the Participant in the Programme.
10. That neither Parent/Guardian has been convicted or is otherwise involved in any criminal offence and/or is not under inquiry or trial by the police or judiciary which has not been disclosed to the organizers in writing nor has the Participant been involved in any case under the Juvenile Justice Act, 2000 (to the extent applicable) or any other prevailing law.
11. To abide by any requirement put forth by the Producer disallowing any apparel which the Producer deems in its absolute sole discretion to be obscene, vulgar, lewd, defamatory, libelous infringing or prominently bears any commercial, company logos, marks, brands or the name/likeness/image of a celebrity or entity.
12. Not to bring any weapons, alcohol or non-prescription controlled substances for any part of the audition and agree to irrevocably allow SPN, Producers and any of their agents to conduct a discreet inspection of the Parent/Guardian belongings to ensure strict compliance of this condition.
13. That this application form is completed truthfully and accurately. Parent/Guardian acknowledges that SPN and/or the Producer reserves the right exercisable at any time at its sole discretion to disqualify the Participant from the competition or auditioning process should the Parent/Guardian at any stage perform or behave in an inappropriate or objectionable manner, supply untruthful, inaccurate or misleading personal details and information about themselves and their wards, break the rules or otherwise be in breach of the terms contained herein.
14. Without limiting the foregoing in anyway, Parent/Guardian agrees to the following:
 - a) Producer/SPN shall be entitled to alter, adapt, or make additions to or deletions from the Programme at its discretion;
 - b) Irrevocably assign to the Producer (including present assignment of future copyright) the entire copyright and all other rights of whatsoever nature in and to contribution of the Participant to the Programme such that the Producer shall be entitled to use and exploit and license others to use and exploit such contribution by all means and in all media and formats whether now known or hereafter invented throughout the universe for the full period of copyright including any extensions and renewals thereto and Parent/Guardian furthermore irrevocably grant all consents and waivers as required by statute to enable the Producer to make fullest use of the Programme without restriction. Furthermore Parent/Guardian hereby waive irrevocably in respect of Participant’s contribution any and all “Moral Rights” which Participant may have now or in the future under the Copyright Act, 1957 or any similar laws of any jurisdiction and acknowledge the Producer’s right to



- use Participant's name, likeness, voice, biographical details, photographs, and recordings in advertising and publicity material.
- c) Make and exploit and to authorize the making and exploitation of any recording or fixation of Participant's appearance separately from or in conjunction with the programming throughout the universe in perpetuity in all media whether now known or here after invented;
 - d) Include the name, likeness, voice, biographical details, photographs of the Participants and recordings of interviews with the Parent/Guardian and the Participant separately from or in conjunction with the programme in all media and formats throughout the universe including but not the way of limitation in advertising, publicity and exploitation material.
 - e) Not to publicise or discuss with any third party without prior written consent from the Producer any information relating to the Programme, Participant's appearance, any of the production team or any participants in the Programme nor any other information which may come to the attention of the Parent/Guardian relating to the broadcaster or the producer or otherwise connected to the Programme save for such information which is already public knowledge.
 - f) To keep the competition rules and the contents of any documents in relation to the Programme strictly confidential.
 - g) If contacted by a member of the press, Parent/Guardian agrees to refer them to the Producer's publicity officer.
15. Parent/Guardian hereby expressly acknowledge that no fees, royalties, residuals, or other consideration will be payable in respect of any broadcast, subsequent rebroadcast or retransmission or any other use by SPN and/or the Producer (or any assignees or licensees) of the Programme or any part thereof in any manner or media now known or hereafter invented.
16. Parent/Guardian agrees to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the Producer, the voting audience, and the panel of judges, which shall be final and binding.
17. Parent/Guardian are aware that the dates and locations of the programme are subject to change and agree that the producer, SPN and/or the production personnel of the Programme, or any person or entity connected with the production, administration or judging of the audition or the Programme, or any of their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, agents or representatives are not responsible for and shall not be liable for:
- i. Any failure or inability for any reason to appear at an audition site or audition or appear before the judging panels;
 - ii. Any costs, expenses, injuries, losses, or damages of any kind caused by travelling to or from the audition venues, being present at the audition venues, participating in the auditioning process or being selected toward or disqualified from continuing in the auditioning process and/or the show;
 - iii. Any printing, typographical or technological errors in any material associated with the Programme.
18. Parent/Guardian acknowledge that SPN and/or the Producers no way warrants, represents, guarantee or promise any rewards or prizes other than those specifically stated in the Programme.
19. Parent/Guardian further represent that he/she is not an employee of, or are a parent, sibling, or child of an employee, of the following:
"SPN, the Producer; the judges; the host(s); production team; any prize providers and any person or entity connected with the production, administration or judging of the auditions of the Programme, and the parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, agents or representatives of any of the above".



- 20. Parent/Guardian agree that the producer may assign all rights in Participant’s contribution to and participation in the Programme to any of SPN’s holding, subsidiary, affiliated, related and/or associated corporations/companies/or successors in the title and to any other third party at any time.
- 21. In the matter of interpretation of any rules and conditions of the Programme, the decision of the Producer and/or SPN shall be final and binding on Parent/Guardian.
- 22. Any dispute shall be subjected to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Mumbai, India.
- 23. Parent/Guardian agrees to the terms, conditions set out above and that all the information given by Parent/Guardian in this form may be used in the programme at the Producer’s sole discretion.
